

Extension of Tram line 15

The extension of the *Tram des Nations* began on 15 September 2025 and will continue until September 2028. With the works, three sections of road are closed to motor vehicle traffic, and are diverted to the *Route des Nations*. Detailed information can be found on the Canton of Geneva website.
